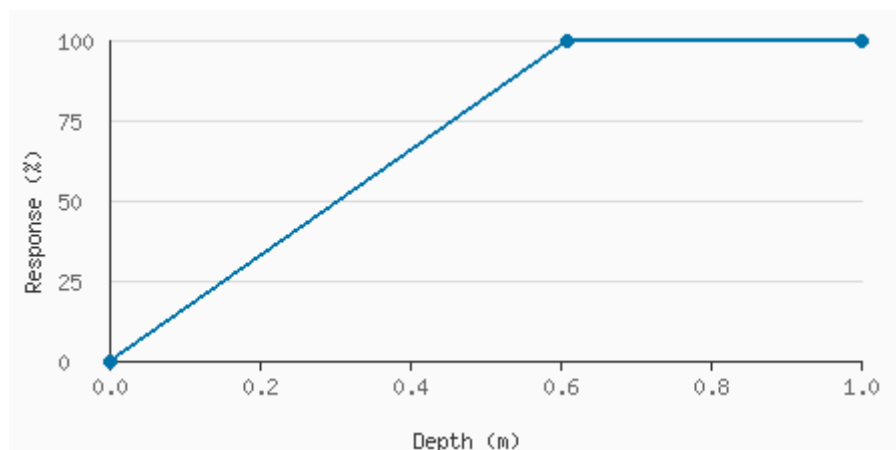
Descriptions

Overview

For Fraser River Rainbow Trout yearlings, depth suitability is similar though slightly shallower compared to the WUP Delphi curve. Suitability also tapers off beyond 90 cm depth for Fraser fish.
